ADVANTAGE:

The Snap-Loc Clip was designed for stand alone pocket lights and personal defense weapons (PDWs).

The open architecture of the clip allows it to be quickly attached or removed. The design is secure and robust. The clip enables a light or baton to be carried tip up or tip down. The unique design of the clip forces the circumferential retaining arms to cantilever against the side walls of the retention groove. The clip is easily removed should it ever fatigue or replaced should it ever become lost.

SPECIFICATION:

- · .040 spring steel
- · Closed end tip
- · Circumferential retaining arms
- · Opposing eccentric locking tabs
- · Heat treated
- · Black Chrome plated
- · Machined retention ring
- · Tensioned clip arm
- · Rapidly attached
- · Oversized loop for jeans or tactical pants
- · Clean appearance when removed

PERFORMANCE:

The ASP Snap-Loc Clip is attached or removed by rolling a retaining arm onto or off of the machined retention ring. The clip may be positioned to carry a baton or light tip up or tip down. The exposure of the grip may also be adjusted.

Removing the clip allows the use of a range of ASP carriers. There is no evidence of clip removal or unsightly screw holes.

SALES STRATEGY:

Demonstrate the ease with which a clip can be rolled onto or off of a P12, P16, Agent Baton or ASP flashlight. Show how the clip cantilevers against the side walls of the retention ring. Point out the closed end tip of the clip.
