A baton with an Agent Grip can be carried tip up or tip down. The Crosstec surface combines with the spaced retention grooves to provide superior holding power.

PERFORMANCE:

The combination of a Crosstec surface pattern with spaced retention grooves provides a superior tactical baton grip. The design resists mars, marks and wear. It will not abrade clothing.

Point out the continuous spiral cut and spaced retention grooves. Demonstrate the superior hold and range of clip adjustments of the Agent Grip.
