Modern police tactical cases rotate to a series of fixed positions on the

equipment belt. The ability to quickly position the case makes it more comfortable to work and the baton or light easier to present. However, a case that rotates 360° may allow the carrier to be accidentally turned upside down and the contents to be dislodged. The 180° rotation of ASP cases solves this problem.

## SPECIFICATION:

- · Easily rotated
- · Seven distinct positions
- · Clicks firmly in place
- · 90° maximum right rotation
- · 90° maximum left rotation
- · May be locked upright

## **PERFORMANCE:**

ASP rotating carriers allow an officer to grasp the body of a scabbard and rotate it to any of seven distinct positions. At each location, the carrier clicks firmly into place. Rotation is a maximum of  $90^\circ$  in either direction. The holder may also be locked in an upright position.

## SALES STRATEGY:

Demonstrate the 180° maximum rotation (90° in either direction) of ASP baton scabbards and light cases. Show how the gross motor adjustment of the holders is both rapid and convenient. Illustrate how carriers can be locked in an upright position.
