FEATURE: Releasable Restraint Lock



ADVANTAGE:

The Training Tri-Fold[®] is designed for use with ASP Training Batons as part of progressive restraint instruction. Beginning with two batons, officers can move to drills with live subjects. Applied to a trainee, the "subject" can roll his wrists to release the restraint and repeat the drill.

This is a reusable version of the industry standard disposable restraint. The Training Tri-Fold assembles, folds, opens and is applied like its tactical counterparts.

SPECIFICATION:

- Designed as a training restraint
- Three fold positions
- Locking block hinge
- Wide, brightly colored straps
- Carried in a standard case
- Applied like a standard Tri-Fold
- Single pull tightening
- Pull hole in each strap
- Recessed identification plate
- Pull ring carry
- Pull ring application

PERFORMANCE:

Training Tri-Folds are designed to be carried in a duty case. They are applied with the standard Pop-Place-Pull protocol. On a Training Baton, they may be slid off, pulled open and reset. On a "subject," the trainee rolls his wrist to release the Tri-Fold which is then pulled open and reset.

SALES STRATEGY:

Compare the Training Tri-Fold to its tactical counterpart. Demonstrate how it assembles, folds, opens and is applied like a duty Tri-Fold. Apply a training restraint using the Pop-Place-Pull protocol. Explain how to release the Training Tri-Fold by rolling the wrist.
