Simple to learn and easy to remember. ASP techniques will be used long after training has ended.

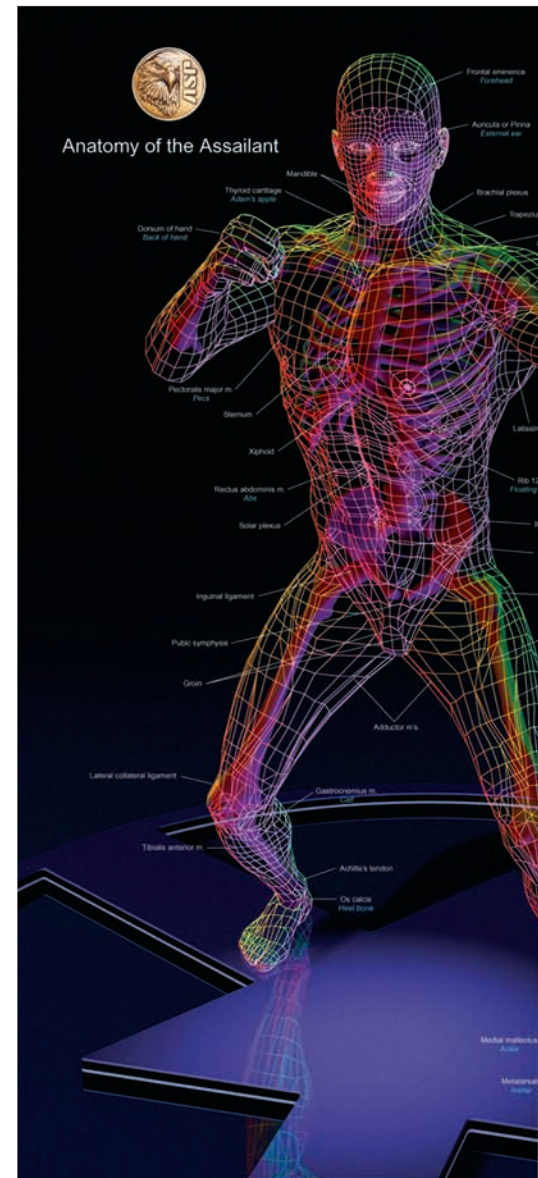
The Corporation

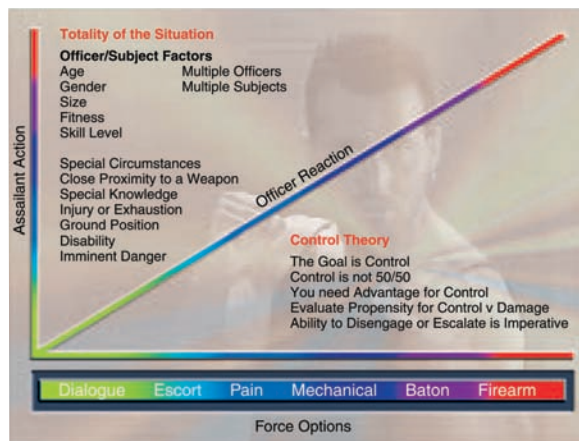
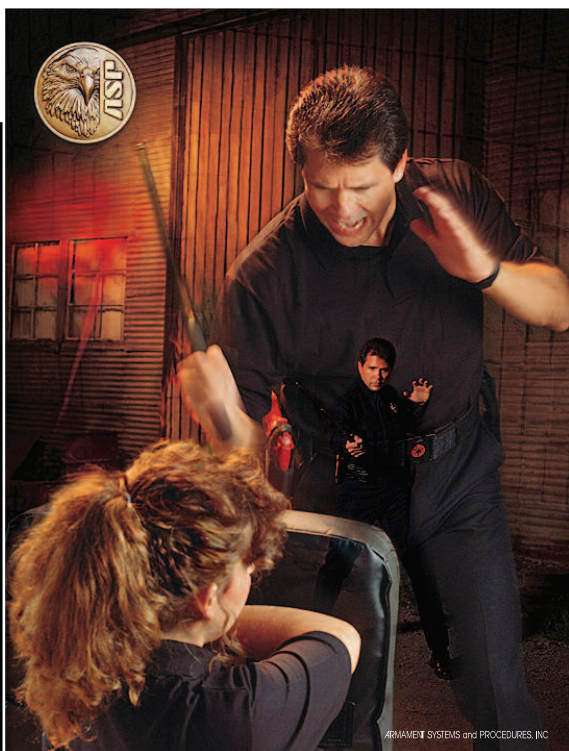
